The evidence shows that the main moral and economic claims that justify the global market are very big lies that are getting bigger and bigger. Industrial agriculture is degenerating the farmland. For example, residues from Bt corn plants after soil removal after harvest inhibits their ability to respire (produce carbon dioxide), also reduces mycorrhizal colonization, and seriously alters bacterial populations within the soil ecosystem.

This function of the soil is of vital importance to regulate the growth and vitality of plants and to increase the availability of minerals and nutrients. Regenerative agriculture is a real incentive for the goal of true holistic “organic regenerative” agriculture without the consumption of chemicals, which should take a more holistic approach that also embraces the well-being of farmers and animals, in a process to which Rodale contributed. , Steiner, Holmgren etc, pioneers of the organic regeneration movement.

Dr. Mercola referenced the Victory Gardens from a few decades ago. Straw Bale Gardening is a new option that makes it possible for almost ANYONE to grow a lot of their own food, even if they only have a small patch of sidewalk or a patio or balcony. This method was pioneered by Joel Karsten 30 years ago, and it is now a global gardening movement. It is a simple process with lots of advantages, including the fact that you do not have to waste time weeding your garden or doing the usual difficult manual labor of digging and tilling the soil. It's very common to get 8' tall tomato plants.

Gardeners get GREAT results, and it is very simple. No special expertise is required. My way of explaining the science of this technique is that we "supercharge the normal decomposition process" over a few days of "conditioning" a bale of straw or hay. After that, we are able to plant seeds or seedlings into the bale, and they are able to access nutrients in the straw, because it has (invisibly) started to transform into early stage soil. Straw works great, but hay is another option, as well as homemade bales using yard waste and compostable materials compressed into a DIY "bale". You can learn all about how to grow this way on a website - StrawBaleGardenClub.com.

We are trying to encourage folks to grow a Neighbor Garden in a visible spot, with just a single bale of straw, to inspire more people to try this easy way to grow more healthy food. When you understand how SBG works, you realize that there is gardening space available almost EVERYWHERE you look. This method is unbelievably easy, and productive, and makes growing your own food an option for almost everyone. I hope some of you will learn more, give it a try, and help spread the word to others, too.
