From March 2020 until December 2022 I could not visit my stroke-disabled demented mother in her publicly funded non-profit nursing home because the administrators had made an illegal rule prohibiting entry to those who had not taken 2 mRNA shots. A holistic healer recommended using Ivermax, a topical veterinary IVM which I bought over the counter from a farm feed store. While I had oral IVM on hand (which can treat Covid at any stage), I opted to use the topical IVM initially on my family (vaxxed and unvaxxed) as soon as they tested positive and did not have to resort to the pill form. My 100 y/o mom who is unvaxxed and has multiple comorbidities responded very well. Covid was literally a walk in the park for all of us.

I purchased the tubes of the horse paste form of it and took it every 3 months as a preventive. I used scales that measure in milligrams. I basically measured the dosages in 10 equal dosages, which is slightly under the recommended dosage of 12mg. The tubes of paste come in 6.08gram tubes at 1.87% Ivermectin. The recommended dosage for humans is 12mg/day for 5 days. So, multiply 6.08 by 1,000mg to get 6,080mg. Then multiply 6,080mg by 0.0187 to get the actual amount of ivermectin in the tube to get 114 total milligrams of ivermectin in one tube (horse dosage).

Dividing that into 10 dosages gives you a dosage of 11.4mg each. 12mg is the optimal dosage for treating Covid, but 11.4mg is close enough and that gives you 10 dosages per tube. Using a scale that weighs in milligrams, weigh your dosages to 608mg. I did this 5 straight days every 3 months. So, one tube would last me 6 months. They are about \$12/tube on Amazon: www.amazon.com/lvermectin-Paste-Bundles-Sticker-Included/dp/B0CM9Q9WHZ.. When I purchased it, I paid \$10/tube at my local Tractor's Supply. After nearly 4 years and at least 50 covid-19 test, I never tested positive.

If so, the only other difference would be the tube size, as the dosages are always based the same, as to the weight of the animal; horse or cow.
